

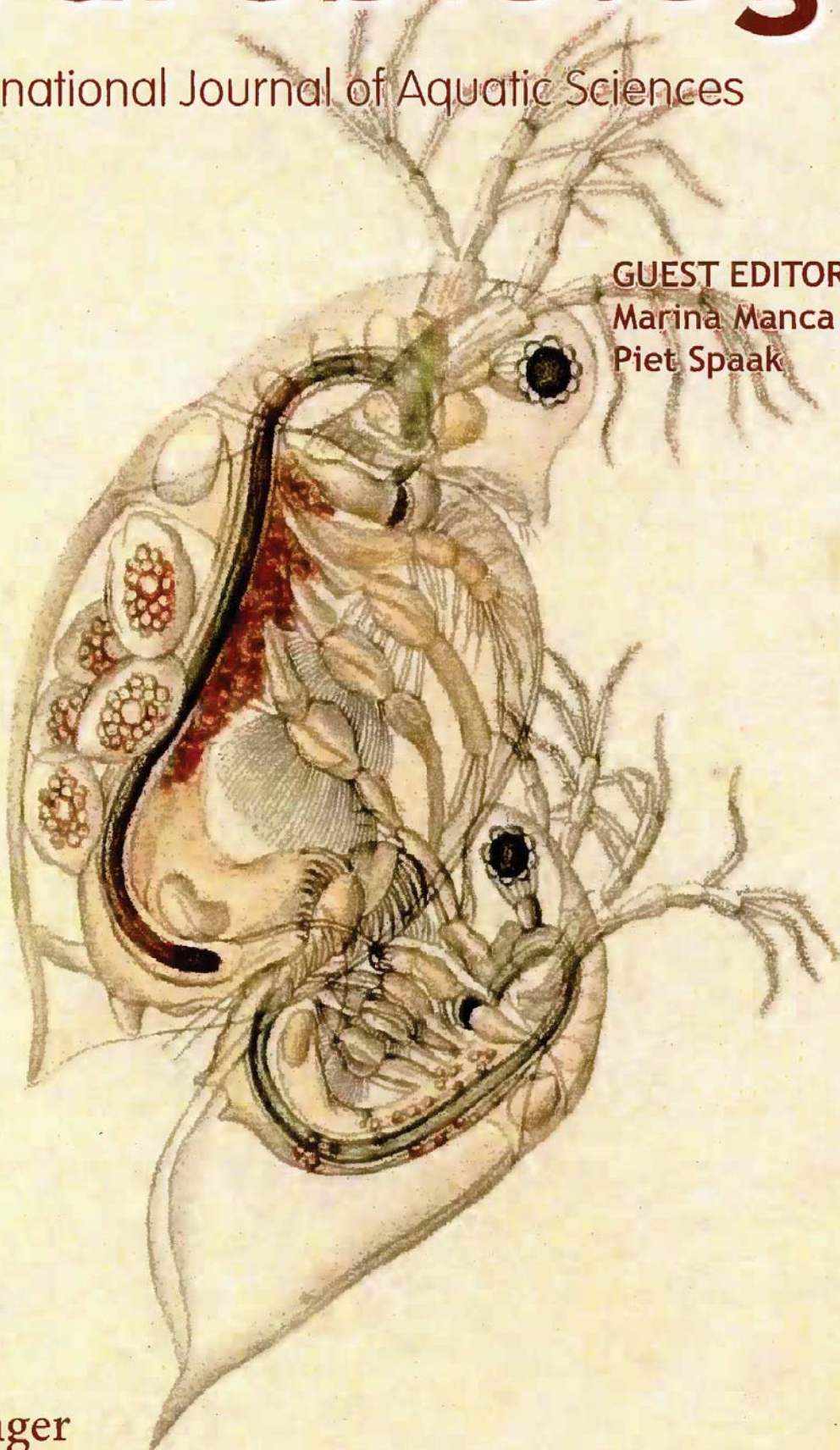

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Cover illustration The cover reproduces an original plate from Jurine's book "*Histoire du Monocles*" (1820). Drawings were made by Jurine's beloved, young daughter Christine, who, like her father, died the year before the book was published. Entitled as "perhaps the person of her gender who has the most merit as a naturalist by her numerous drawings relative to Natural History", Mad.^{elle} Jurine "unites the talents of an artist with the art, more difficult than you would imagine, of a good observer; also her drawings are not recommended any less for their elegance as for their rigorous exactness" (Jurine, 1920).

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
